Team/Club/Group Bingo Volunteer Policy

Tiger Bingo provides a fundraising opportunity to athletic teams, clubs, and groups to support the students in school sanctioned activities. Tiger Bingo schedules bingo-worker volunteers by groups who fill a “slot”.

Teams/Clubs/Groups who wish to raise funds through Tiger Bingo must be approved by the Booster Board. For approval, Teams/Clubs/Groups submit an application form for the board to review and must also commit to having a meeting with the Bingo representative. They also, must have a team/club/group parent in addition to the coach or advisor who will take responsibility for recruiting and organizing volunteers for the date selections that are made.

Athletic teams will have first priority in making selections. Clubs and groups will have second selection.

Out of season and special teams, clubs or groups will be able to make selections once all in season teams have made their selections.

Three months prior to the start of each sport season, in season teams will be able to select 3 slots to provide volunteers for bingo. Teams that have large rosters, 50 students or more, will be able to select 5 slots.

An email will be sent to the coach and parent representative of each group who will be active in the designated season. The email will indicate available dates.

The teams will have 2 weeks to select slots and to communicate those selections to the bingo representative.

Teams will also be able to indicate if there is interest in additional dates if available. Additional dates will be allocated to teams/clubs/groups on a first come first serve basis.

Year round groups and clubs will be able to choose 2 slots each season.

If there are additional slots in a season, out of season teams, year round clubs, and groups will be able to select dates. All clubs and groups will need to follow the same policy for selecting dates as all athletic teams.

Teams/clubs/groups that are consistently unable to provide volunteers will not be able to select slots for a minimum of 1 season or 4 months.

Bingo volunteer staffing is 3 slots per Saturday

1 slot:

- 3 parents volunteers 4-10 pm \$60/parent
- 5 student volunteers – set up 1:30-3:00 pm \$10/student
- 5 student volunteers – clean up 9:00-10:30 pm \$10/student
- \$120 bonus if all students and parents arrive on time, bringing the total credits to \$400

Super Saturdays (Saturdays after Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years and one other holiday weekend) will be announced at the Coach's meeting at the beginning of the year and offered to all athletic teams on a first come first serve basis. Teams will be given one Super Saturday slot until all requests have been filled and then will be given additional slots if requested. If Super Saturday slots are not filled by athletic teams by October 1st, they will be offered to clubs and groups on a first come first serve basis. Each parent volunteer working on a Super Saturday will receive an additional \$40 bonus.

Saturdays when large crowds are anticipated may require an extra slot and/or extra committee members as decided by the Bingo VP and Bingo Committee.
